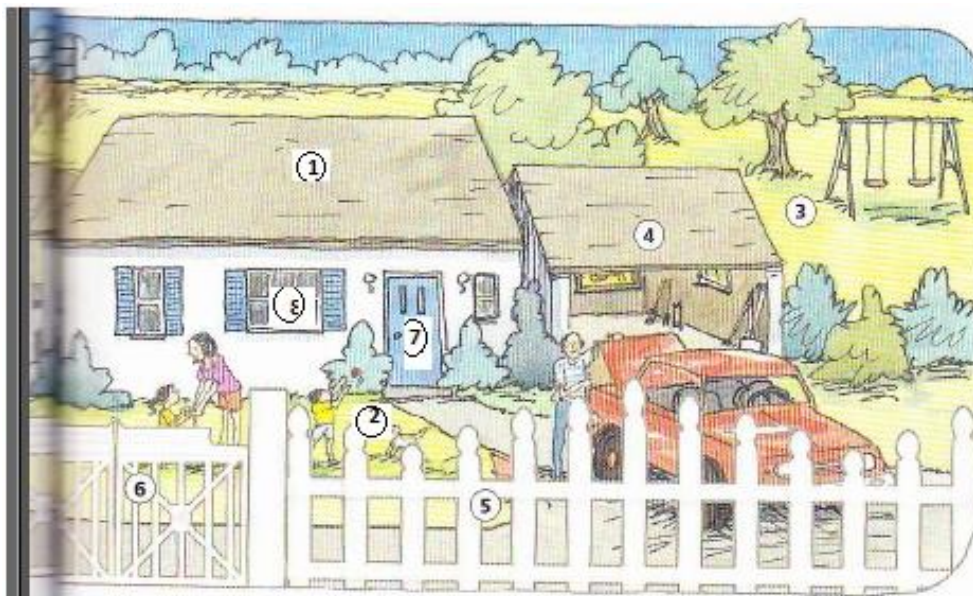

Grammar (fitsipika)

I read the sentences *(Dinihiko ny fehezanteny)*

My sister **does** the laundry and I **do** the shopping.

My mother makes the bed and I **cook** dinner.

My mother and I **clean** the house and Jaona **washes** the dishes

I learn *(Mianatra lesona aho)*

The verbs **does/do, makes/cook, clean/washes** are in the **simple present tense**.

(Amin'ny filazam-potoana "simple present tense" ireto "verbs" ireto: does/do, makes/cook, clean/washes).

With "**I/you/we/ they**" the form of the verb in the simple present tense is: **to+ verb**.

*(Esorina ny "to" eo alohan'ny verb = **to+ verb**, rehefamiaraka amin'ny (I/you, we, they) amin'ny simple present tense).*

With "**he, she, it**" or a **singular noun**, we add "**-s**" or "**-es**" to the verb = **to+ verb+s/to+ verb+es** when the verbs end in "**-o**" like **do/go** and in **-sh** like **wash**.

*(Ampiana "**-sna -es**" = **to+ verb+s/ to+ verb+es** ny "verbs" miafara amin'ny "**-o**" toy ny "**do/go**" ary **-sh** toy ny "**wash**" rehefa "**he, she, it**" na **anaranatokana** no miaraka aminy).*

We use the simple present tense **to talk about actions we do every day or repeatedly**.

(Ilazana asa atao isan'andro na matetikany simple present tense).
