**Husband** = vady lehilahy

**Wife** = vady vehivavy

**Children** = zanaka (mihoatra ny 1 nyisany)

**Daughter** = zanaka vavy

**Son** = zanaka lahy

**Sister** = rahavavy/ anabavy

**Brothe** = rahalahy/anadahy

**Parents** are **husband and wife**.

**Children** are **son and daughter**.

We use **"is"** when it is singular (I, you, he, she, it) and **"are"** when it is plural (we, you, they).

(*"is" no ampiasainarehefaolona iray nazavatra iray na biby iray nyLazaina (toy ny I, you, he, she, it) ary "are" no ampiasaina rehefa mihoatra ny iray ny isany (toy ny we, you, they).*)

3. Ann and Tim are **Jack's and Mei's** children.

→ Ann and Tim are **their** children.

**II-I learn** (*Mianatra lesona aho*)

**“Her, his and their”** are called possessive adjectives. A possessive adjective is used to **replace the name of the possessor in order to avoid repetition.**

(*Possessive adjectives no fiantsony “her, his ary their”. Ny mpisolotena tampisaka na “possessive adjective” no ampiasaina mba tsy hamerimberenana ny anaran’ny tompon-javatra*).

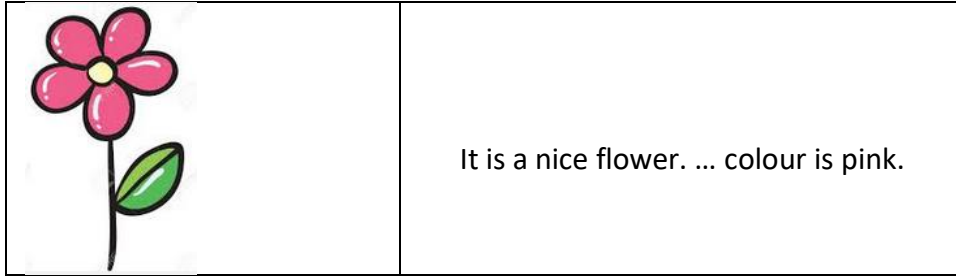
