COURSE SUMMARY

When we narrate,

- 1. We use the past simple:
 - Regular verbs : V+ ed (eg: start → started)
 - Irregular verbs (bewas; begin → began)

Remark: For regular verbs ending in "y", if the verb is ending in:

CVC: V → + ed	play → played
VCC: y → i+ed	study → studied

2. We use the sequence markers to make a coherent story:

First Then Next After that Finally

3. This is the content of the narration.
