I learn (Mianatra lesona aho)

The verbs of likes are: **to like, to love** and **to enjoy**

(Ny matoateny ilazana ny zavatra tiana: *to like, to love and to enjoy*)

The verbs of dislikes are: **dislike, hate** (ny matoateny ilazana ny zavatra tsy tiana: *dislike, hate*)

The form is: love/like/enjoy+ Noun (example: I like shorts) or enjoy+V-ing (example: you enjoy wearing).

Don't like= dislike, hate

**I learn the vocabulary by heart** (*lanarako tsianjery ny voambolana*)

**Like/love/enjoy**= tia

**Dislike/hate**=tsy tia, mankahala

**Wear**= manaoakanjo, pataloha, kiraro, satroka, kavina...

**Grammar** (*fitsipika*)

Mirana **likes** shorts.

Haingo **doesn't like** the dress but she **likes** the skirt.

Mirana and Haingo **like** shoes but they **don't enjoy** dress.

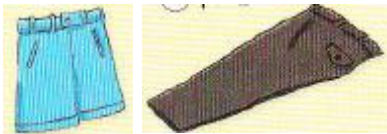
## I-Simple Present tense

| affirmative        | negative                    |                        | interrogative           |

| I like this dress  | I/we/you/they<br>Don't like | he/she<br>doesn't like | Do you like this dress? |
| He goes to school  | Don't go                    | doesn't go             | Does he go to school?   |
| She washes dishes  | Don't wash                  | doesn't wash           | Does she wash dishes?   |
| They learn English | Don't learn                 | doesn't learn          | Do they learn English?  |

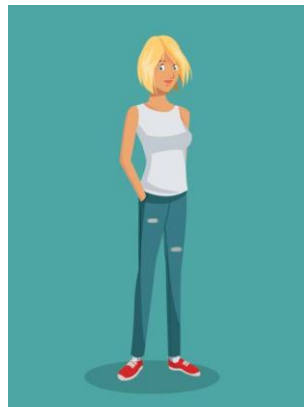
