The possessive case

Example: What is the job of Bill?

→ What is **Bill's** **job**?

↑ ↑
The possessor **the possession**

I learn (Mianatra lesona aho)

The possessive case is used to indicate **the relationship between the possessor and the possession**, that is to say a person or an animal or a thing belongs to another person. We add an apostrophe (') and an-s to a name of a person or an animal to make the possessive case.

(Ilazana ny fifandraisana misy eo amin'ny tompon-javatra sy ny fananany ny "possessive case". Izany hoe, milaza fa ny olona iray na ny biby iray na ny zavatra iray dia fananan'olona iray hafa. Ampiana faingo mihantona (') sy -s ny anaran'olona na biby na zavatra rehefa hanao "possessive case").

I add a possessive to the person's name (Ampiako "possessive case" ny anaran'olona)

Example: The **name** of **the taxi-driver** is Bill.

→ **The taxi-driver's** **name** is Bill.
