Remark : When the introductory verb is in the present tense, there is no changes with the tenses of the verb

Activity 1 Underline the correct answer :

Direct Speech : Mother says: "Father is coming today."
Reported Speech : Mother says that Father is coming today/that day/ the previous day.

2. Direct Speech : They says: "This is our book." Reported Speech :They says that **this /that** is **our/their/theirs** book."

3. Direct Speech : Vony says to herself : "I wander what am I going to do tomorrow".

Reported Speech : Vony says to herself that **she/I** wanders what **am I / is she** going to do **the next day/ the previous day/ tomorrow**.

4. Direct Speech : Jery says to Rija : "I quarreled with my mother this morning. I can't go out and play with you now". Reported Speech : Jery says to Rija that I/he/they quarreled with their/his/my mother this/that/ then morning. I/He/They can't go out and play with you/her/him now/then/that day.
