Expressing contrast			
But	To join two sentences, and the second sentence is the contrary of the first sentence. S+V+O, but + S+V+O	I used to be scared of spider, but I'm not scared of spider anymore.	

	To join two sentences, and the second sentence is different from the first sentence. We use a comma. S+V+O, but + S+V+O	I used to be scared of spider, but my brother used to be scared of mice.
However	To join two sentences, and the second sentence is. We use a period S+V+O. However, + S+V+O	I used to be scared of dark. However, I'm not scared of dark anymore.
Whereas	To connect sentences We use a period. S+V+O. Whereas + S+V+O	I used to be scared of dark. However, I'm not scared of dark anymore.

Remark: We never begin a sentence with "but" and "and"
I used to be scared of spider. And I killed them.
I used to be scared of spider. But my brother used to be scared of mice.
